

Rosary

How to Pray the Rosary



1. Make the Sign of the Cross and say the Apostles' Creed.
2. Say the *Our Father*.
3. Say 3 *Hail Mary's*
4. Say the *Glory Be to the Father*.
5. Announce the 1st Mystery; then say the *Our Father*.
6. Say 10 *Hail Mary's* meditating the mystery.
7. Say *Glory Be to the Father*.
8. Announce the second mystery, say the *Our Father*. Repeat 6 & 7 and continue with the 3rd through 5th Mystery in the same manner.
9. After each decade say the Jesus Prayer "O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, lead all souls to Heaven, especially those who have most need of your mercy."
10. At the end of the rosary, say the "Hail Holy Queen."
